The picture above is from one of our Youth Conferences. We had over 300 in attendance, with 18 different churches represented.

April is always a busy time of year throughout much of Southeast Asia—especially in Cambodia, Laos, and Thailand. In addition to our regular ministry responsibilities—soul-winning, discipleship, and teaching in Bible college—April is also Conference Month.

During this time, schools and many workplaces close, making it an ideal opportunity to host conferences, both Youth Conferences and Bible Conferences. These events are always a great blessing.

This year, our ministries in Cambodia, Laos, and Thailand hosted three Youth Conferences, with more than 600 in attendance. I also had the opportunity to preach three times at another Bible Conference. Altogether, I had the privilege to preach seven times and taught two split sessions.

We saw at least 45 teenagers trust Christ, along with hundreds more who made potentially life-changing decisions for Christ and His cause.

It was such a blessing to have Bounna, his wife Thy, and four of our faithful laborers from Cambodia join us for one of the conferences in Laos. Bounna preached and taught several encouraging split sessions. As always, he and Thy were a tremendous blessing to everyone—especially the teens and children. They are a huge blessing wherever they go!

Our fellow laborers from Cambodia—Samnang, Noi, Makara, and Thida—were also a great encouragement. I truly believe that all eight of us received a greater blessing than we gave.

During two of the conferences, I asked five pastors—men whom I have taught, disciplined, and labored with over the years—how many people had trusted Christ through their ministries over the past 13 years (the time I have been in Asia). Their answer was truly remarkable: more than 4,000 professions of faith, with nearly half of those converts having been baptized. Keep in mind, this was just five pastors and their ministries in one communist country.
